

## Guide for Sendai City Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

### ■ For the Vaccination

**Receiving the Vaccines is Not Mandatory.** The vaccine will be given based on the recipient's own decision after they understand both the efficacy for preventing infections and side effect risks. The vaccination will never be given without the recipient's consent.

If you are currently undergoing treatment for any diseases or have any concerns about the vaccination due to your physical condition, please consult with your family doctor in order to decide whether or not to receive the vaccination.

**Eligible Persons** Those who are applicable to each requirement and whose residence registration is in Sendai City as of the day of receiving vaccination.

The first and second doses: Those who are aged 12 or older

The booster (third) dose: Those who aged 18 or older after approximately eight months have passed since receiving the second dose (the vaccination tickets will be sent by the City of Sendai to eligible residents accordingly. Please ask the Sendai City Call Center for COVID-19 Vaccination if you cannot receive the ticket due to moving into Sendai after receiving the second vaccination or any other reasons.)

**Fee** Vaccinations are free of charge

※ Suspicious phone calls which demand payment for the vaccine or try to draw out personal information have been reported. If you receive a suspicious call, please consult with the nearest police station or Sendai City Consumer Affairs Center (Tel: 022-268-7867).

### **The Number of Doses**

● The first and second doses

**【Pfizer Inc. Vaccine】** Normally when receiving the Pfizer Inc. vaccine, the second dose is to be given three weeks after the first one. If three or more weeks have passed since receiving the first dose, please make sure to get the second dose as soon as possible.

**【Takeda/Moderna Vaccine】** Normally when receiving the Takeda/Moderna vaccine, the second dose is to be given four weeks after the first one. If four or more weeks have passed since receiving the first dose, please make sure to get the second dose as soon as possible.

● The Booster (third) dose

**【Booster dose】** One dose only vaccination

### ■ How to receive vaccinations

◎ Have you received your vaccination tickets?

If you have not received or have lost the tickets sent by the City of Sendai, please contact the Sendai City Call Center for COVID-19 Vaccination at ☎0120-39-5670.

① Select the type of vaccine administration and make a reservation

There are three options for the way of vaccine administration such as “Individual Vaccination” at medical institutions, “Mass Vaccination” at temporary venues including Shimin center (civic center), and “Large-scale Vaccination.” The method for making reservations differs for each type of vaccine administration.

● Individual Vaccination



Medical institutions such as hospitals or clinics in the city

Reservations can be made at each medical institution.

Please check availability of each medical institution on the webpage of the City of Sendai and make a reservation accordingly such as by telephone.

● Mass Vaccination



Vaccination venues such as Shimin center (civic center)

Please make a reservation online or by telephone. Reservations for the first and third doses cannot be made at the vaccination sites.

● Large-scale Vaccination Tohoku University (Sendai, Miyagi) Vaccination Center (4F, Yodobashi Camera Multimedia)



Only the third dose will be provided. Please make a reservation on online, through by LINE, or by telephone.

Do not forget to cancel unnecessary reservations.

If you need to cancel your reservation due to unavoidable reasons, please be sure to cancel your reservation accordingly prior to the day of vaccination. If you do not cancel it correctly, others may not be able to make reservations or the vaccine will have to be discarded.

② Receive Vaccinations at

On the day of vaccination please ensure you are in good health before coming to the vaccination venue. The vaccine cannot be administered to people who have a fever or are feeling ill.

◎ Must bring items on the day of vaccination

◆ Your vaccination tickets: The tickets for the first and second doses are stickers on a sheet. Please bring the whole sheet without removing the sticker parts.

The ticket for the third dose is an all-in-one form with a Prevacination Screening Questionnaire and its left part is a vaccination certificate. Please do not tear them apart.

◆ Personal ID documents: Residence card, Driver license, National Health Insurance card, etc.

◆ Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire

You can prepare the questionnaire in advance and bring it in on the day of vaccination to ensure you can get through the reception process quickly.

※ Please safely store your vaccination tickets after receiving your first dose as those are also required for the second dose.

※ Please also safely store the certificate as it will be proof of receiving vaccination.

■ In the case of a health injury resulting from the vaccinations against COVID-19

Generally, side effects of vaccinations may cause health injuries (such as falling sick or leaving an impairment). Although this is incredibly rare, risks are inevitable, thus a relief system has been established for this reason.


