
① Language


When children leave the house, they lead their daily lives entirely in Japanese. At home, speak in your own language and make sure your children don't forget the language. Children are also studying their own native language.


You can tell your children important things in your own language.

Japanese Used in School Studies


Japanese used when studying Japanese, arithmetic, sociology, science etc.

This is why there is kanji practice and textbook reading in children's homework. Make sure your children study a little bit everyday at home.

From the point when children begin studying Japanese until they can understand their teacher's well, takes anywhere from 1 to 2 years. Of course children are trying their best at this time. Please be sure that all caregivers are giving the child plenty of praise. Please also be sure to talk with children about world news, the importance of peace, environmental

issues and other things which may be important to your child on a frequent or daily basis.
