Children's Association (kodomo-kai)

The goal of these activities is to promote the healthy development of children through increasing exchange between parents and children, and providing opportunities for parents and children to come together and better understand each other. Participation in these events requires paying dues. Some examples of events that the children's association participants in are social gatherings, town festivals, welcoming

School and Family

► PTA

PTA helps foster cooperation between the school and parents to plan events for the benefit of children. They host various events like lectures and bazaars, and meet to talk about their children. Dues are collected from members to fund PTA events.



PTA is an abbreviation of Parent Teacher Association.

After-school day-care

After school care is available for children 1st grade through 6th grade. This care will take place either at the school or a nearby citizen's center or children's center.
