

# Five-level evacuation information which is given out during times of heavy rain

Alert Levels 1 and 2 will be announced by the Japan Meteorological Agency and Alert Levels 3 through 5 will be announced by the City along with other evacuation information. Make sure to take appropriate evacuation measures based on the Alert Level.



**Alert Level 1**

Check current weather information.

**Alert Level 2**

Confirm evacuation routes used to run away and where your closest shelters are.

**Alert Level 3**  
けいかいれべるさん  
警戒レベル3

Evacuation for the elderly and other at risk groups

こうれいしゃとうひなん  
(高齢者等避難)

If elderly or physically impaired, please evacuate. Everyone else should prepare to evacuate.

**Alert Level 4**  
【Full evacuation】

警戒レベル4  
ぜんいんひなん  
【全員避難】

Evacuation Order  
ひなんしじ  
(避難指示)

It is very dangerous because of a disaster occurrence. Please evacuate immediately.

**Alert Level 5**  
けいかいれべるご  
警戒レベル5

Secure Safety Urgently  
きんきゅうあんぜんかくほ  
(緊急安全確保)

A disaster is occurring. Please take appropriate measures to protect your life.

Urgency increases from levels 1 to 5
